



#### **BLM Nevada Budget Report**

2019

- 3 Competitive Oil & Gas lease sales
- July 2019 200 parcels offered on 390,000 acres
- Receipts received \$183,000 for the 2019 oil & gas
- \$8,276,000 Revenue for O&G/Geothermal
- \$5,352,000 Disbursement to State & Counties



#### **Solid Minerals**

- Nevada
  - 205,000 Active mining claims
  - 5,581,000 ounces of Gold produced value of \$7.08 billion
  - 144,655,000 lbs. of Copper produced value of \$428 million
  - 12,908,000 lbs. of Lithium compounds value of \$64.6 million
  - 12,400,000 tons value of \$11 million
  - \$8.1 billion value of Solid Minerals commodities



# Fire and Fuels Management

- 2018 Fire Season
  - 649 fires for 1,001,966 ac
    - Human 361 fires for 600,000 ac
    - Lightning 288 fires for 401,688 ac
    - Martin Fire over 400,000 ac
- 2019 Fire Season
  - 509 fires for 79,792 ac
    - Human 298 for 11,971 ac
    - Lightning 209 for 67,821 ac





# Fire and Fuels Management

- Hazardous Fuels Management
- Anticipated to achieve over 110,000 acres of hazardous fuels treatment
  - This is an all time high for BLM Nevada
- Hosting a statewide interagency hazardous fuels workshop in October
- Emergency Stabilization and Burned Area Rehabilitation
- Completed 307, 891 acres FY19 for Emergency Stabilization (1-2 years post fire)
- Completed 175, 026 acres for Burned area rehabilitation (2+ years post

fire)



# Rangeland Management

- Outcome Based Grazing Nevada is home to five of the 11 outcomebased grazing pilot projects being piloted by the BLM
- Targeted Grazing & Fuel Breaks BLM Nevada has one of two landscape-scale demonstration projects to test targeted grazing to reduce fine fuels.



#### **Horse and Burro Program**

- Adoptions over 230 horses have been adopted in FY19
- Next saddle-trained horse & burro adoption will be in Carson City in cooperation with Northern Nevada Correctional Center Oct. 19 −15
- BLM Nevada has removed a total of 4,119 horses and 188 burros in FY19

 BLM Nevada plans to remove an additional 1,495 horses and 775 burros this year.

- Burning Man 2019
- California Trail Center
- Red Rock Canyon NCA, Sloan Canyon NCA, Basin and Range NM, Gold Butte NM



#### **Nevada Outdoor Recreation Economy**

- 87,000 Direct Jobs
- \$12.6 Billion in Consumer Spending
- \$4 Billion in Wages & Salaries
- \$1.1 Billion in State & Local Tax Revenue









# Renewable Energy Development

- Gemini Solar Project EIS Largest proposed solar array in the United States (690MW, enough to power 400,000 homes)
- September 2019 Competitive Geothermal lease sale 142 parcels over 385,000 acres - Largest sale ever for Nevada and BLM
- State of Nevada's recent renewable energy portfolio standard of 50% renewable energy by 2030
- Transmission is essential for future development



#### Wildlife Fish, and Plants

- Partnerships
  - BLM-Nevada is engaged in multiple partnerships with our state, federal, and tribal partners
- Nevada public lands span two broad ecosystems:
  - Great Basin Nevada has the second largest area of intact sagebrush habitat, for Greater Sage-Grouse, mule deer, pronghorn, elk and Desert bighorn sheep
    - State of Nevada legislation and CCS for Greater Sage-Grouse
  - Mojave Desert Home to many iconic species such as the Mojave Desert tortoise, desert dace, desert pupfish, and Joshua Tree.
